

9. Public Information and Communication

ICD is bound by its statutory responsibility as a provider of QQI-validated programmes to ensure that certain information is made publicly available and that it is clear, accurate, up-to-date and easily accessible. Representative information includes:

- The college's quality assurance procedures, evaluations/reports, and quality improvement plans
- Information relating to the accreditation/validation of programmes and the NFQ awards which they lead to
- Information about validated programmes' curriculum, structure, learning outcomes, and assessment strategies
- Procedures for access, transfer, and progression
- Details of the college's established procedures and policies with respect to the protection of enrolled learners (PEL)
